Advanced Agri-Solutions will offer the locked price rebate fuel contracting program.

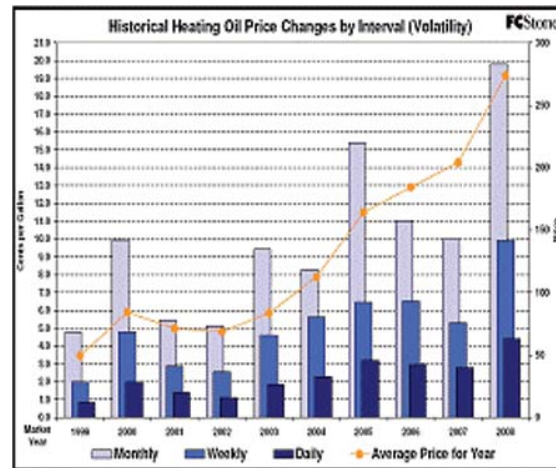
How Does it Work?

A sign up period will take place Monday, July 28 through Thursday, July 31. On Friday, August 1, the fixed price will be set, which will be the top price you the producer will pay for contracted gallons, with the potential to earn a maximum rebate of .40 cents a gallon.

The rebate price will be calculated at the end of the contracting period in November. At this time an average of three months will be taken, which will derive the amount of the rebate to be given.

When Will the Gallons be Delivered?

The delivery period you, the producer, are contracting for is September, October and November of 2008.



How Much can I Contract?

The minimum amount is 1,000 gallons for the three month period, however no maximum limit is set.

What Products can be Contracted?

Only farm and road diesel will be offered through this program at the present time.

What is the Cost?

There will be an enrollment fee attached to the contract. It will be on a "per-gallon" basis. The fee will be set Monday, July 28. An estimate is .18 cents for the maximum price contract with a cap price at .20 cents. The fee will need to be paid during the July 28 through July 31 sign up period to lock in the gallons.

Example of Rebate

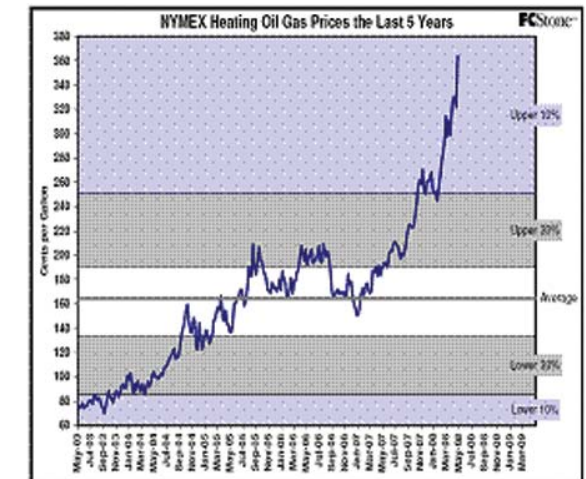
Market Price Increase

If the market price increases in the three month time period, no rebate will be given, because your fuel has been received at a lesser cost.

Market Price Decrease

Should the market price decrease, the averaged rebate will then be given to compensate the decrease. For example, if the average price drop was .15 cents, the rebate received will be .15 cents, with a maximum rebate up to .40 cents. Again, this is rebated per gallon.
